






IN THE FIRST FIVE YEARS WE HAVE...

- been acknowledged by the Scottish Government as key stakeholders in the justice system
- given evidence to the Justice Committee of the Scottish Parliament and joined four Cross Party Groups
- agreed with government the use of 'people with convictions' in place of 'ex-prisoners' and 'ex-offenders'
- instigated a change in the law to make it possible for prisoners to be released one or two days early if this would improve their prospects for rehabilitation
- facilitated prisoner focus groups in connection with draft legislation and policy reviews



- participated in the redesign of community justice in Scotland and the design and implementation of Independent Prison Monitoring of Scottish prisons
- delivered awareness raising sessions for members of the judiciary, Scottish Prison Service staff and Parole Board members
- worked with SPS HQ and RBS to make it possible for prisoners to open basic bank accounts prior to release
- taken the lead role in bringing together public, private and third sector organisations to establish a network of employers to increase the recruitment and employment opportunities for people with convictions


